

Weekly Themes

Week 1, June 27-July 1 *Sowing and Growing Our Garden*

Take advantage of our raised bed and learn about the foods and flowers that we grow. We will sprout seeds, plant herbs and vegetables, and learn about the plants and creatures that grow in our garden.

Week 2, July 5-8: *Waterside Adventures*

Learn about life in the oceans, lakes, ponds, rivers, and streams. We will study plants and animals that make watery places their home, from giant whales to tiny tadpoles and everything in between.

Week 3, July 11-15: *Whimsical Music and Movement*

We will explore how our bodies can move, balance, stretch, and dance and learn the ways we can make music as well.

Week 4, July 18-22: *Creating Treasures out of Recycled Goods*

There is a world of useful objects and crafts that can be made with the things we often toss away. We will learn how to repurpose and make use of everyday items.

Week 5, July 25-29: *The Magical World of Color and Shapes*

Explore the world of art starting with color and shapes. We will study different types of art and bring out the creative artist in each of us.

Week 6, August 1-5: *What Lives in Our Backyard*


How exciting is our own backyard? We will spend the week learning about the bugs, birds, bats, and other creatures that share our school and home spaces.

Clothing- lightweight clothing that can get messy is best. We spend a lot of time outside, so children should be able to move and climb freely. As for footwear, sneakers are best. Children should also bring a hat, bathing suit, water shoes, and a towel for playing water games outside.

What to bring-

Sunscreen and insect repellent- please apply sunscreen at home before coming to camp. Campers will have additional sunscreen and insect repellent applied as needed during the day.

Lunch- Pack your child a lunch and snack in an insulated lunch box with a cold pack. We provide water to drink throughout the day. We are unable to heat food during the summer months. Please remember that we are a **nut-free** school.

Extra clothing- Please pack at least one complete change of clothes in a ziploc bag, and pull-ups and wipes if needed. **Label Everything.**
